

# Viewing Your GradeMark Paper

## How to View your GradeMark Paper

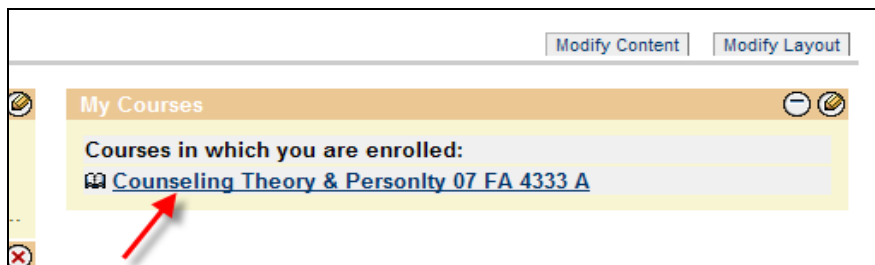
A *GradeMark* paper is an online assignment that you turned into Blackboard. It contains comments on the paper's content and/or style.

Below you will find the directions for opening your GradeMark paper in Blackboard. First, read these two important notices:

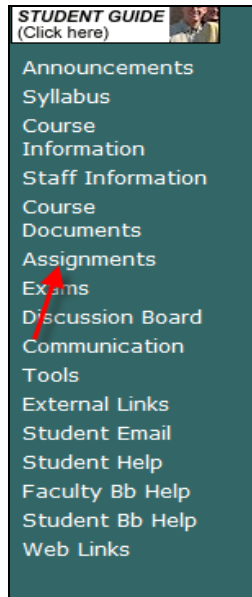
- You will be able to view a GradeMark paper only if your professor has provided one.
- If your professor has directed you to look for a GradeMark paper, follow these directions carefully. You cannot view your GradeMark paper via the *My Grades* section of Blackboard. You must go to the *Turnitin Assignments* page – these directions will step you through the procedure.

## Follow these directions:

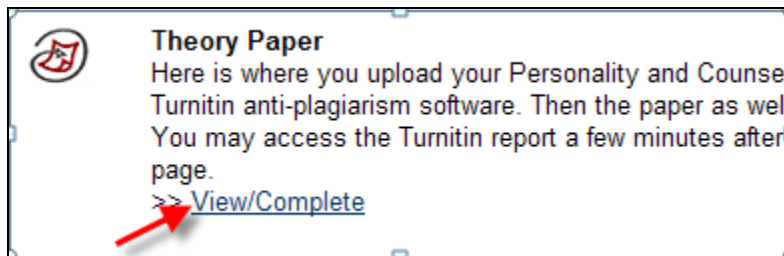
1. Log into Blackboard and navigate to the course which has your paper.



2. Most GradeMark papers are located in the course Assignment area. Click the *Assignment* link to go to your course Assignment area.




3. Find the Turnitin Assignment to which you submitted your paper and click the *View/Complete* link.



4. Click the *GradeMark* icon to view comments made by your professor regarding your paper. The GradeMark icon looks like this:
